Things you should know

Note: This application is for replacing or duplicating the same type of license plates. For example, use this form to replace standard auto plates with standard auto plates, or Packers plates with Packers plates.

To change license plates to a **different type**, different applications and fees may apply. See http://wisconsindot.gov/drivers/plateguide/special.htm for applications and fees.

Stolen personalized license plates:

Please be aware that when you receive the duplicate plates, you may be stopped by law enforcement in any state for possession of stolen plates. If you choose to keep the same personalized message, we will send additional documentation to confirm that you are the rightful owner of these plates.

Sesquicentennial license plates:

Replacement and duplicate Sesquicentennial plates are no longer available. Customers will receive free, standard design plates. For further information, please email special-plates.dmv@dot.wi.gov or call (608) 266-3041.

Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) and Firefighter license plates:

If you currently have the white design and would like to change to the new red and white design, send \$40 and complete the vehicle information on the *Civilian License Plates Application* form, MV2652.

How to apply

- 1. Complete and sign this application.
- 2. Make check or money order payable to: Registration Fee Trust.
- 3. Mail application and fee to:

Do not send your vehicle title with this application.

Replacement license plates (nonpersonalized):

A new license plate number will be issued. Expect delivery within 1–2 weeks.

Upon receipt of the new plates, destroy the old plate(s). If plates are stolen, notify your local law enforcement of the stolen plate number.

Duplicate license plates (personalized):

Only the following special-interest plates can be duplicated:

- » Personalized plates of any type
- » Collector/Collector cycle
- » Collector Special
- » Hobbyist/Hobbyist cycle
- » Amateur Radio

Duplicate plate(s) with the same personalized message or unique number will be issued. Expect delivery within 3–4 weeks.
